



Factsheet for auditors

The Dean of Studies has issued this fact sheet pursuant to Art. 77(1) of the University Statutes of 25 October 2010.

Admission

You can be admitted as an auditor, i.e. as someone who wishes to attend lectures without intending to earn any credits, if you have the necessary educational background. Permission can be granted for a maximum of 10 semester week hours, provided that lecture places are free and the relevant faculty members give their consent.

Registration

You can register with the special form that is available on the website of the University of St.Gallen. The registration deadlines are listed on the form.

Fees

CHF 30.00 will have to be paid for each semester week hour in the semester. This fee will be charged regardless of whether the lecture of your attendance covers the whole semester or only part of it.

Examinations

Auditors are not entitled to sit examinations (Art. 78 (1) of the University Statutes of 25 October 2010).

Language courses

You can only register for language courses through the range of courses offered by the University's [Language Center](#).

Residence permit

Auditors of foreign nationality cannot obtain a Swiss residence permit from the University of St.Gallen. Without a permit, they may stay in the country for three months.

Library

The [library](#) will inform you about their borrowing regulations.

Insurance

The University does not provide any personal insurance cover.

Car park regulations

No parking permits can be granted to auditors. We expressly recommend that you come to the University by public transport (train and bus) since the University of St.Gallen only has an extremely limited number of parking facilities.

If you would like to travel by car nonetheless, please use the large [public car parks](#) (please note the street-sign system that indicates free places in the various municipal car parks) or the [Park & Ride](#) car parks, and then catch a [bus](#) to the University.
